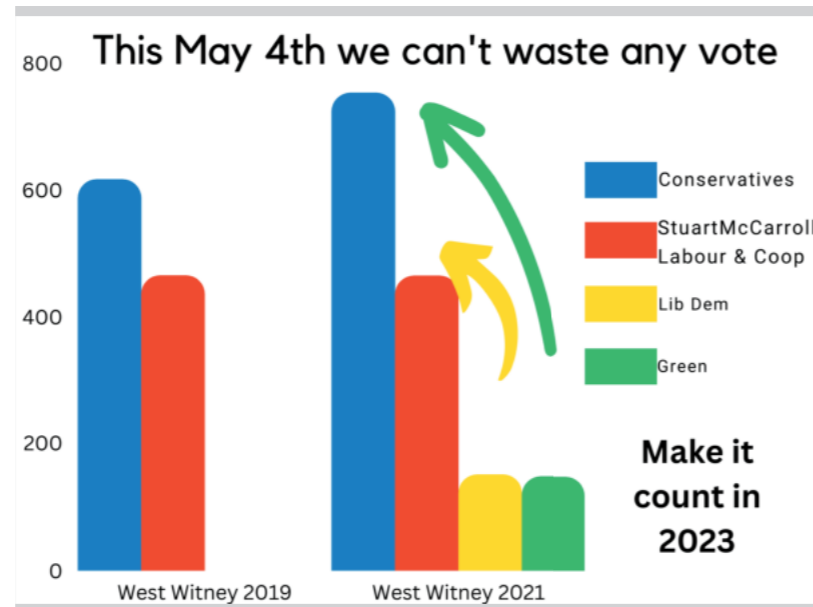
## Help build new brighter future for West Oxfordshire. Vote Labour 4th May
