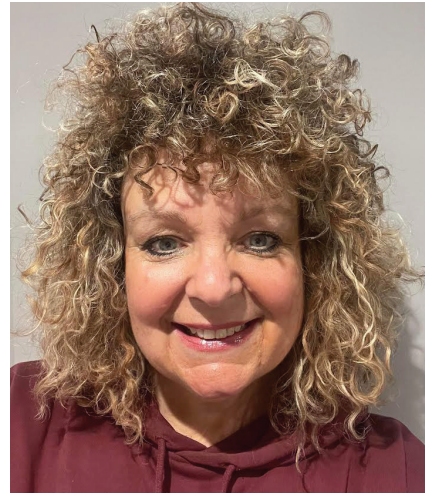


# Why we're voting for ANDREW COLES

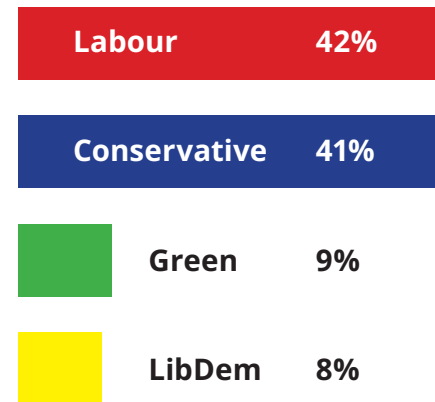

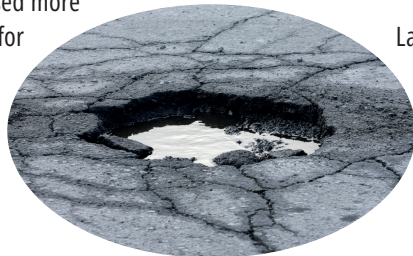
In 2015 Andrew was honoured by the then Conservative Mayor of Witney, receiving a Certificate of Outstanding Merit for Service to the Community.

### OUR ROADS

Our roads and pavements are in a dreadful state. Funding for road maintenance has fallen dramatically over the last 14 years.

As someone who drives professionally for a living, Andrew knows first-hand the problems and continues to campaign for improvements and repairs. At the county council recently, Labour councillors successfully argued for an extra £5million for pothole repairs.

Rishi Sunak recently promised more funding for local councils for pothole repairs over the next 2 years, let's hope it's not too long in coming, we desperately need the repairs here in Witney!



### OUR RIVER

Andrew has long campaigned against the appalling discharge of raw sewage in our rivers, including here in Witney in the River Windrush. Nothing epitomises the current decline of Britain more.

Andrew attended a demonstration in Witney and spoke at the rally calling on the Tory government to intervene and act, they are the only ones with the power to stop this and hold the water companies to account.

Labour will clean up our waters with mandatory monitoring of all sewage outlets and automatic fines for sewage dumping.
